Language Arts:

- Recognize letters.
- Identify a corresponding lower-case and capital letter.
- Demonstrate evidence of literal and inferential comprehension.
- Recall details from a story.
- Retell a story.
- Develop the ability to draw conclusions.
- Identify colors and color words.

- Memorize a poem and perform finger play motions.

- Identify a number and make a set containing the corresponding number of items.
- Determine if one group has more than, is less than, or is equal to another.
- Identify an item that does not belong in a set.
- Identify a number that comes before or after a given number.
- Develop a strategy to win a game.
- Develop calendar skills.
 - Learn the days of the week.
 - Identify the day that comes before or after a given day.
- Make a bar graph.
- Make a picture graph.
- Identify shapes:

- Create and extend a color pattern.

- Group letters by characteristics.

Science:

- Describe the weather.
- Use observation skills.

Social Studies:

- Understand that actions have consequences.
- Learn a home address.

- Play cooperatively.

Art:

- Use various mediums to create original art: pencils, crayons, paint.
- Make a puppet.
- Use a sponge and paint to make sponge prints.
- Make a diorama.
- Trace a pattern.
- Make a collage.
- Make a bead bracelet.

Music:

- Sing the alphabet.
- Improve coordination through motions that keep time with music.
- Clap a rhythm pattern.
- Sing a song about colors.
- Participate in a musical color walk.

Physical Development:

- Develop large motor skills.
 - Jump and balance.
 - Accurately roll a ball and knock over items..
 - Build a block tower.
 - Accurately toss bean bags.
 - Play hide and seek.
 - Perform locomotive activities: wave, clap, hop, turn around, etc.
- Develop small motor skills: cutting, gluing, painting, tracing.
