- Learn about fall.

- Engage in sensory play activities.
- Use creative adjectives to describe the feel of fresh and dried pumpkin seeds.
- Help cook pumpkin seeds.
- Color a rainbow.

Social Studies:

- Understand that actions have consequences.
- Learn a home address.

Art:

- Use various mediums to create original art: pencils, crayons, paint.
- Make a puppet.
- Use a sponge and paint to make sponge prints.
- Use patterns to make the parts of a turkey. Follow directions and glue the parts together.
- Make leaf-rubbing patterns.
- Color by number and shape.
- Make a diorama.

Music:

- Sing a song about fall.
