

# Lesson 32

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## Skills:

- ❖ Record information using a bar graph.
- ❖ Recognize and name the hard sound of **Cc**.
- ❖ Create and illustrate a story.
- ❖ Use different mediums to create art.

## Materials:

- ❖ Snack-size bag of M&M's or Skittles
- ❖ Flashcards: alphabet
- ❖ 11" x 14" piece of construction paper
- ❖ Worksheet 32

## Calendar:

- ❖ Continue routine activities.

## Math:

- ❖ Empty the bag of candy onto the table. Have the child separate the pieces into sets by color. Choose two color sets, and make a pattern. (AB AB AB or AAB AAB, etc.) Then use three color sets to make a pattern (ABC ABC or AB AC AB AC). Continue to make other patterns. Use all of the sets to complete the bar graph on worksheet 32 and show how many candies of each color are in the bag.
- ❖ After the graph is complete, eat the candies.

## Language Arts:

- ❖ Use the **Cc** flashcard to teach the hard sound "c," as in "cat." Say the sound and have the child repeat it. Name things that begin with the letter **c**. Review other letter sounds.
- ❖ Create a story together using this story starter:

One sunny day, a big, (color) (animal) went on a walk. He passed a pretty (color) flower that smelled so good. He skipped down a hill and then rolled in the (color) grass. A little (color) (animal) swam and splashed in the (color) lake. What a beautiful day!

- ❖ Have the child draw an illustration for the story. For a more challenging activity, have the child copy the story on handwriting paper strips and glue each sentence to a different sheet of white

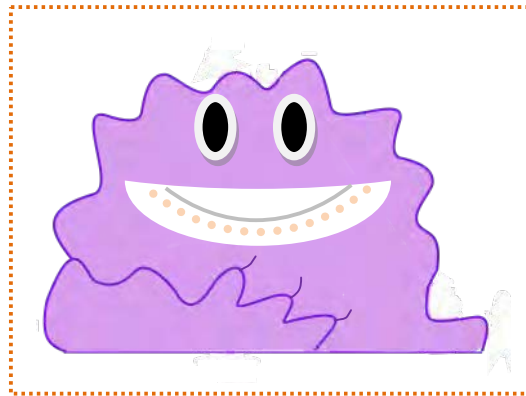
paper. (Point out the capital letter at the beginning of each sentence and the punctuation mark at the end.) Illustrate each page, and staple the pages together as a book.

## Physical Education:

- ❖ Cut different-colored shapes and hide them around the room or the house. Play hide and seek with the shapes, and have the child find all of them. Reverse the activity, and allow the child to hide the shapes for you or a sibling to find.

## Enrichment:

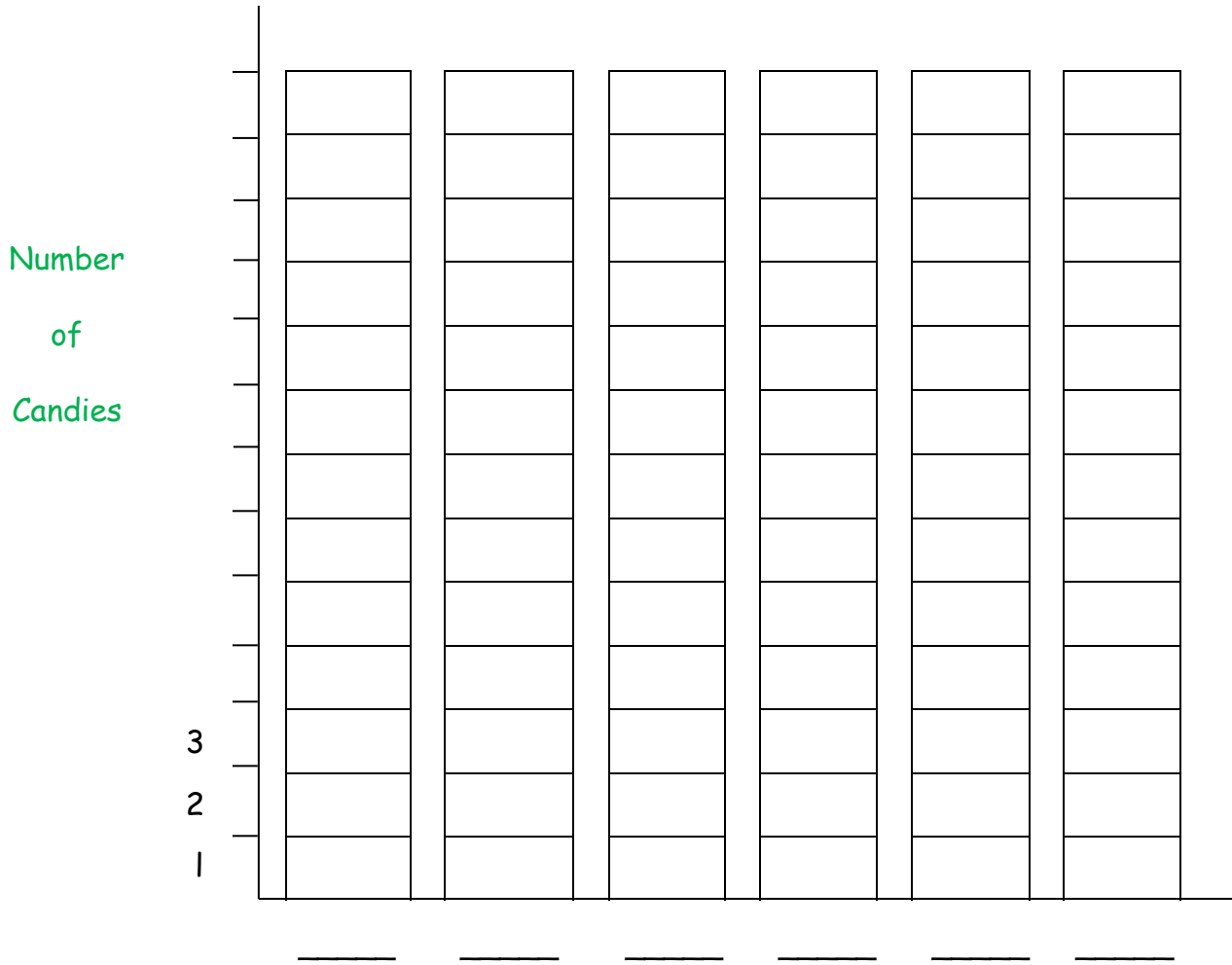
- ❖ Use the saved pumpkin seeds to create a silly creature's smile.
  - Cut a four-inch circle from colored construction paper.
  - Fold it in half. Open it and glue seeds around the inside.
  - Close the circle on the fold. Set it aside.
  - Draw the silly creature's face on a large piece of construction paper.
  - Glue the half circle in the center of the face.
